In order to satisfy the continuing education requirements for recertification, you must meet both the continuing education total hourly requirements and the Clinical Patient Care requirements; and also satisfy the CPR regulatory requirement.

**Please Note: Effective January 1, 2020 EMSVO's will be required to have the required EMSVO hours recorded on their Continuing Education Record to reregister their EMSVO certification.**

CPR Regulatory requirement: You must maintain a Basic Life Support (BLS) Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) certification from a program approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Health for use by EMS candidates and EMS providers for: Admission to EMS education programs and examinations, initial certification, certification by endorsement, recertification, renewal, recognition and registration within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Continuing education credits are applied to the three-year certification period in which the programs are COMPLETED. The class completion date, i.e. last date of class, must fall within the three-year CERTIFICATION period. As a reminder, credit will be awarded for a course only one time in your certification period.

Your certification period begins with the Effective Date 7/26/2018 and ends with the Expiration Date 12/31/2019 as shown on your certificate and card.

If you are an EMS Provider and/or Emergency Medical Service Vehicle Operator (EMSVO) whose certification is currently registered, prior to the expiration of the registration period you must successfully complete continuing education credits (**three continuing education credits if the registration is on a 3-year renewal cycle or two continuing education credits if the registration is on a 2-year renewal cycle**) in subjects regarding effective driving of a ground EMS vehicle. The continuing education requirements for registration of an EMSVO certification are in addition to those imposed upon an EMS provider for registration of an EMS provider certification.

If you are an EMS Provider and/or Emergency Medical Service Vehicle Operator (EMSVO) and have met all of the requirements for reregistration prior to the expiration date shown above, you will be receiving new certification materials within 60 days of your expiration date.

The continuing education requirements for Pennsylvania EMS providers and vehicle operators are defined in the Emergency Medical Services System Act, act of August 18, 2009, P.L. 308, No. 37, as may be amended, 35, Pa.C.S. Section 8101, et seq., and duly promulgated rules as regulations (Title 28, Chapters 1021-1033) adopted October 11, 2013, effective October 12, 2013, 43 Pa.B. 6093, unless otherwise noted, as published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.

Remember: Sections 8113(i)(4) of the EMS System Act, 35 Pa.C.S. § 8113(i)(4), and 28 Pa. Code § 1023.21(b)(4) require an EMS provider and an EMSVO to report and provide to the Department a certified record of a misdemeanor, felony or other criminal conviction that is not a summary or equivalent offense and disciplinary sanctions that have been imposed upon a license, certification or other authorization to practice an occupation or profession, including driver's licenses, within 30 days after the conviction or disciplinary sanction. To report a conviction or disciplinary sanction, please contact the regional EMS council listed in the preceding paragraph. Failure to do so may impact your certification status.
